

# Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Access Program

The Access Program supports students' entry into RMIT University programs (courses) through an informal interview process. It also takes into account relevant life, work, education and training experience. The program is exclusively for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islanders and confirmation of Aboriginality will be required.

## How to apply

Follow these three steps:

1. Apply to RMIT via the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) via [www.vtac.edu.au/applying/courses.html](http://www.vtac.edu.au/applying/courses.html) or direct to RMIT via <http://bit.ly/applyforstudy>
2. Apply for the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Access Program via <http://bit.ly/applyngarara>
3. When steps 1 and 2 are complete, Ngarara Willim Centre (NWC) staff will be in contact to arrange an interview.

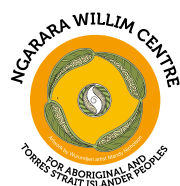


## Benefits of applying through the Access Program

- Students will receive full support from NWC staff throughout the application process and throughout their studies at RMIT.
- Applications will be assessed based on previous study, work, and/or community and leadership experiences.
- The program is managed by NWC and offers a non-competitive based entry into a program as long as students have met the prerequisites.
- Students will be provided with a fantastic opportunity to make connections and get started at RMIT through a compulsory one-day orientation in February or mid-year.
