Gama-dji Orientation Program

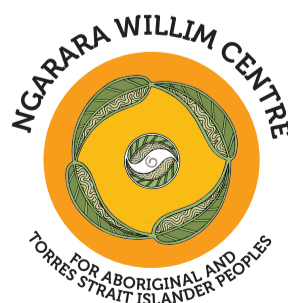
- Helps students to transition into tertiary education better prepared, more confident and aware of support available.
