General Scholarships

RMIT Indigenous Study Support Scholarship

VALUE

\$2,500 (per year)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time certificate IV, diploma, degree or postgraduate by coursework students.

RMIT Equity Notebook Grant

VALUE

Notebook computer

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time certificate IV, diploma, degree or postgraduate by coursework students.

Gama-dji Grant

To buy books and course materials and a four-month gym membership.

VALUE

Up to \$1000 (one-off payment)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time certificate IV, diploma, degree or postgraduate by coursework students. Must attend Gama-dji Orientation program in February or mid-year.

Evelyn Boekemann Scholarship

VALUE

Up to \$1000 (one-off payment)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time diploma or degree students who can demonstrate financial and/or educational disadvantage.

Inder Kaur Reconciliation Scholarship

VALUE

Up to \$10,000 per year (for up to five years)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time, female certificate IV, diploma or degree who can demonstrate financial and educational disadvantage.

Commonwealth Scholarships

Indigenous Education Scholarship (IES)

VALUE

\$2,599 (per year for up to four years)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time bachelor degree students commencing at RMIT who can demonstrate financial disadvantage.

Indigenous Accommodation Scholarship (IAS)

VALUE

\$5,199 (per year for up to four years)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time bachelor degree students commencing at RMIT who can demonstrate financial disadvantage, re-locating from remote or rural locations.

Indigenous Commencing Scholarship (ICS)

VALUE

\$4,904 (one-off payment)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time bachelor degree students commencing at RMIT who can demonstrate financial disadvantage.

Course-specific Scholarships

Herbert and Inge Littauer Nursing Scholarship

VALUE
\$2,500

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time students enrolled in the Diploma of Nursing (C5313) or the Bachelor of Nursing (BP032) who can demonstrate financial and/or educational disadvantage.

McCraith Scholarship in Architecture

VALUE
\$7,000

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time students enrolled in the Bachelor of Architectural Design (BP250) or the Master of Architecture (MC163) who can demonstrate financial and educational disadvantage.

McCraith Scholarship in Fine Art

VALUE
\$7,000

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time students enrolled in the Bachelor of Arts (Fine Art) (BP201) who can demonstrate financial and educational disadvantage.

Northcote Trust Scholarship

VALUE
\$5,000

WHO CAN APPLY?

Full-time students who are progressing, or have progressed, from a diploma to a degree program in a similar field, and can demonstrate financial and/or educational disadvantage.

Indigenous RMIT Accommodation Scholarship

TYPE

Financial assistance for your own rental/shared accommodation.

VALUE
\$5,200 (per year)

DURATION

Duration of your full-time program.

BOND REQUIRED

N/A

OTHER INFORMATION

This is the only accommodation scholarship available for mid-year intake.

Indigenous RMIT Village Accommodation Scholarship

TYPE

Accommodation: two-bedroom studio apartment located in North Melbourne. Suitable for RMIT City campus students.

VALUE
\$12,180 (2016).

This scholarship will cover rent and utilities only.

DURATION

First year of full-time study

BOND REQUIRED

Yes - \$1140 (2016)

OTHER INFORMATION

Indigenous UniLodge @ RMIT Bundoora Accommodation Scholarship

TYPE

Accommodation: four-bedroom multi-share apartment located at Bundoora campus. Suitable for RMIT Bundoora campus students.

First year of full-time study

BOND REQUIRED

Yes - \$760 (2016)
